## MISSION

Implementation of the 2021-2027 European Social Fund Plus (ESF+) Policy Objective 4 "A more social and inclusive Europe "Priority 2.1.1 - Education and training Specific objective 4 f "Equal access" - "IN STUDIO 2025" and the measures aimed at housing support for students pursuant to Art. 2 letter i) of Regional Law no. 6 of 27 July 2018 "Provisions for the recognition and support of the right to study and the promotion of knowledge in the Region", with the contribution of Regione Lazio, Assessorato all'Università Direzione Regionale Istruzione, Formazione e Politiche per l'Occupazione.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

The call for applications contains symbols that link to additional explanations, aimed at facilitating compilation of the application.

An example of this is the "**see attachment**" command, marked by the following icon: . Clicking on the icon opens up multimedia content that the student may view before proceeding to fill out the application. The multimedia supports can also be viewed on the online application form. However, the text of this call for applications is the only complete and correct guide based on which applications may be submitted.

We recommend paying the utmost attention when filling out the application.

### Students' duties

- Students are required to frequently check the "Messages", "My position", "Payments", and "Ticket Service" sections from the "Menu" of their reserved area at [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it);
- Before filling in the application form, students must view the support materials available on the web page devoted to this call for applications at [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it);
- Students are obliged to formally communicate any changes to the information already provided in the application by opening a ticket, under penalty of having the competition position reviewed.






This refers in particular to the following changes:




- personal information (tax code, residence, domicile, etc.);
- withdrawal from/forfeiture of studies;
- graduation during the period between 01/10/2025 and 31/07/2026;
- scholarships or grants provided by bodies other than DiSCo;
- any changes to the rental agreement;

Should such omissions result in the failure or substantial modification of one or more of the mandatory admission requirements laid down in the notice, DiSCo will proceed to exclude the student.

## DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this call, the following shall apply:

- a) **university**: the universities and academies of art, music and dance (AFAM) listed in Annex A , based in the Lazio Region and issuing legally valid qualifications;
- b) **student**: any person who enrolls in courses at one of the universities indicated in above point a) for the 2025/2026 academic year;
- c) **beneficiary**: any student who, having been declared a “beneficiary” in the final ranking, following the checks and verifications carried out, is deemed to possess the requirements stated and envisaged by this call, and maintains said condition throughout the entire academic year of reference;
- d) **eligible**: any student who, having been declared “eligible” in the final ranking, following the checks and verifications carried out, is deemed to possess the requirements and maintains said condition throughout the entire academic year of reference, but who was not deemed as a “beneficiary” due a lack of resources;
- e) **in-town students**: students residing in the municipality in which the university courses are held;
- f) **commuter students**: students who live in the municipalities indicated in Annex B  of the “CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE RIGHT TO STUDY 2025-2026” or in any case within 50 kilometres from the municipality in which the course of study is held;
- g) **out-of-town students**: students residing in regions other than Lazio or the municipalities indicated in Annex C , available online at [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it), or in any case over 50 km from the municipality in which the course is held, and who do not receive any grants/subsidies from public or private entities for said purpose and for the same academic year;
- h) **location of the studies**: the municipality where the course of studies is held or, in the case of several locations, the location where the predominant number of hours are held;
- i) **application form**: the online form to be filled out and submitted by students in order to participate in the call for applications;
- j) **reserved area** : the section of the site [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it) accessed via SPID/CIE. International students with residence outside Italy may access the reserved area for the first time through registration and in-person identification by one of the affiliated CAFs. International students who have already gone through this procedure can log in with their assigned credentials. Communications issued by DiSCo in this section have legal value;
- m) **system**: the coordinated and integrated set of computer software and procedures on the website [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it) that are used to acquire the applications for the benefits, verify the data acquired and process the results;
- n) **territorial coverage**: the DiSCo office to which student refer for administrative activities related to the competitions and requested benefits. The relative office is identified according to the university in which the student is enrolled, pursuant to Annex A ;
- o) **graduating student**: the student who has been awarded DiSCo accommodation for the 2024/2025 academic year and who graduates by March 2026, or at a later date, but still with reference to the 2024/2025 academic year;

- p) **DSU** (*Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica*): the document containing the personal, income and asset details necessary to define the household economic position required to calculate the ISEE indicator, in order to apply for subsidised benefits for the right to study;
- q) **ISEE**: (*Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente*): the Indicator of the Equivalent Economic Situation is an indicator used to evaluate and compare the economic situation of households, identified by DCPM 159/2013 and necessary in order to apply for subsidised benefits. This notice will examine the **university ISEE**, i.e. the indicator determined by a specific type of DSU. The documentation relating to the university ISEE calculation does not need to be attached to the application, as DiSCo acquires the ISEE/ISPE values independently by querying the INPS database. The DSUs must be signed by the deadline of 31/12/2025;
- r) **ISEEUP** : The Equalised University Indicator of the Equivalent Economic Situation, used to evaluate and compare the economic situation of the households of international students not resident in Italy. This model is the result of an agreement between the CAFs and DiSCo and is adopted in all cases where it is not possible to calculate the university ISEE, specifically:
- international student not resident in Italy;
  - international student resident in Italy, not independent and with family members resident abroad;
  - Italian student resident abroad and not registered with AIRE (*Anagrafe degli Italiani Residenti all'Estero* - Register of Italians Living Abroad).
- The documentation relating to the ISEEUP calculation does not need to be attached to the application, as DiSCo acquires the ISEEUP values independently and exclusively from the affiliated CAFs through computerised systems. The ISEEUP must be signed by the deadline of 31/12/2025. Students who have not signed a DSU for the ISEEUP at an affiliated CAF within the above deadlines are excluded from the benefits, and no documentation produced after this date will be accepted, even if in original copy;
- s) **affiliated CAF**: tax advisory centre accredited by DiSCo to issue the ISEEUP certificate valid to apply for this Call for applications. The list of affiliated CAFs is available on DiSCo's institutional website ;
- t) **SPID**: the public identity certification system enabling citizens to access the public administration online services, through a single digital identity via computer, tablet and smartphone;
- u) **CIE**: the Italian Electronic Identity Card defined pursuant to Ministerial Decree of 23 December 2015, equipped with elements for the physical identification of the holder, issued on electronic media by municipal administrations;
- v) **TICKET**: a communication request sent to DiSCo through a specific IT management system that can be found in the student's reserved area. Note that in the current Call for applications, the "ticket" is identified as the "student's only means to communicate with DiSCo";;
- w) **independent student**: an Italian or foreign student who has been residing in a place other than that of their family of origin for at least two years prior to the date of submission of the application and in accommodation not owned by a member of their family, and who has had declared income from employment or similar sources, for at least two years, of at least € 9,000.00 per annum;
- x) **Student Code**: the alphanumeric code generated by the system that uniquely identifies the student to protect their privacy. The Student Code is visible in the student's reserved area and replaces the personal references in the various rankings and in any publication concerning DiSCo services;
- y) **small municipalities**: all municipalities in Lazio with a population of less than 5,000 inhabitants .

## ART. 1 Housing vouchers for rent

1. The total amount of resources allocated by DiSCo to cover this call for applications is € 5,000,000.00.
2. The measure to support university students enrolled in public and private universities or academies of art, music and dance (AFAM), legally recognised, active and with registered office in the Lazio Region, which issue legally valid academic qualifications, resident and/or domiciled in Lazio and without age limits, consists of a housing voucher in cash, differentiated according to the area where the rented property used by the beneficiary is located, in particular:

### **A. Properties and facilities located within the area of the City of Rome:**

- € 350.00/month (three hundred and fifty euros/month), for a maximum of 10 months (October 2025 - July 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 3,500.00 (three thousand five hundred euros), for rental agreements for properties situated in the City of Rome;
- € 350.00/month (three hundred and fifty euros/month), for a maximum of 6 months (October 2025 - March 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 2,100.00 (two thousand one hundred euros), to **graduating** students for the 2024/2025 academic year who are already beneficiaries of a place in the DiSCo university residences situated in the City of Rome, pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2024/2025, for rental agreements for properties situated in the City of Rome;

### **B. Properties and facilities located in municipalities with a population of less than 5,000 inhabitants (attachment small municipalities ):**

- € 250.00/month (two hundred and fifty euros/month), for a maximum of 10 months (October 2025 - July 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 2,500.00 (two thousand five hundred euros), for rental agreements for properties situated in the municipalities with a population of less than 5,000 inhabitants;
- € 250.00/month (two hundred and fifty euros/month), for a maximum of 6 months (October 2025 - March 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 1,500.00 (one thousand five hundred euros), to **graduating** students for the 2024/2025 academic year who are already beneficiaries of a place in the DiSCo university residences, pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2024/2025, for rental agreements for properties situated in municipalities with less than 5,000 inhabitants;

### **C. Properties and facilities located in the remaining provinces and municipalities of Lazio:**

- € 200.00/month (two hundred euros/month), for a maximum of 10 months (October 2025 - July 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 2,000.00 (two thousand euros), for rental agreements regarding properties situated in municipalities of Lazio other than the City of Rome;
  - € 200.00/month (two hundred euros/month), for a maximum of 6 months (October 2025 - March 2026) - equal to a maximum of € 1,200.00 (one thousand two hundred euros), for **graduating** students for the 2024/2025 academic year who are already beneficiaries of a place in the DiSCo university residences situated in Latina, Cassino or Viterbo, pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2024/2025, for rental agreements regarding properties situated in municipalities of Lazio other than the City of Rome.
3. For rental agreements with start and/or end dates that do not coincide with the first and last day of the reference month, respectively, the grant amount will be adjusted.
  4. Within the financial and time limits detailed above, letters A, B and C of previous point 2, the refund obtainable may not exceed the amounts paid by the student, as inferred from the data contained in the contract registration and certified by valid tax receipts relating to payment of the rent.

## **ART. 2**

### **Beneficiaries**

The contribution for the payment of rent may be requested by university students residing and/or domiciled in Lazio who:

1. are enrolled in one of the following types of courses, by 31/12/2025 for academic year 2025/2026, at one of the institutions with headquarters in Lazio:
  - degree;
  - master's degree;
  - single-cycle master's degree, with the exception of students of medicine, dentistry and veterinary medicine attending the filter semester;
  - PhD programmes, except for students benefiting from scholarships, research grants, or any other grants from the University or other Institutions;
  - post-graduate school, except for medical students who are the beneficiaries of scholarships, internship contracts or other benefits and remuneration;
  - graduating students, as defined in the previous section "Definitions".

Students enrolled in online universities, as listed on the mur.gov.it website, are not eligible for the competition. Students enrolled in other universities that offer online courses must attend at least 51% of their courses in person. DiSCo will verify this directly with the relevant universities.

Students who are behind in their studies from the third year onwards are not eligible for the competition. DiSCo will verify this directly with the relevant universities.

Students who enrol provisionally and do not complete their enrolment by 31/12/2025 are not eligible for the competition.

2. have a university ISEE or ISEEUP relating to income and assets for the year 2023 of less than or equal to € 30,000.00, signed no later than 31/12/2025;
3. are "beneficiaries of accommodation" who have not yet taken possession of their accommodation, and "eligible non-beneficiaries" of accommodation, as identified pursuant to the Call for Applications for the "Right to Study 2025/2026". In such cases, DiSCo will be responsible for checking any changes in status;
4. are excluded from accommodation in the final ranking of the "Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2025/2026";

## **ART. 3**

### **Compatibility**

1. The grant is compatible with other benefits/allowances already being received, with the exception of those already granted by public or private institutions for the same purpose (for example, this grant is not compatible with INPS grants), and those awarded by DiSCo for the academic year 2025/2026 specifically related to housing. For out-of-town students who have been awarded a 2025/2026 scholarship, DiSCo will carry out checks on their status before publishing the final list of those admitted/excluded, proceeding with exclusion.

2. The housing allowances provided for and governed by this notice, the six different types of which are specified in Article 1, paragraph 2, letters A, B and C, cannot be combined. The sum of the amounts received for both the scholarship and housing allowance benefits may not exceed the maximum total amount provided for the scholarship for out-of-town students, equal to € 7,072.10, as defined in the "DiSCo Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2025/2026". In this case, the value of the housing voucher is calculated as the difference between the maximum amount of € 7,072.10 and the amount of the scholarship awarded to the student.

## **ART. 4**

### **Determination of requirements**

To be eligible for the housing voucher, students must meet the following requirements:

1. have a university ISEE/ISEEUP relating to income and assets for the year 2023 of less than or equal to € 30,000.00, with DSU signed by 31/12/2025 (at the time of application, for statistical purposes, DiSCo will ask, among other things, whether the candidate's university ISEE is lower than or equal to € 27,948.60).

#### **Independent students**

Without prejudice to the income and assets limits provided for in this article, to be considered an independent student, Italian or international, both of the following requirements must be met simultaneously:

- independent residence from the family of origin for at least two years prior to the application date and in accommodation not owned by any family member;
- income of at least € 9.000,00<sup>1</sup> per year earned either from a regular employment contract or similar, and declared for tax purposes.

Should these requirements not be satisfied, students must integrate their income with that of their family of origin at the CAF (Tax Advisory Centre) by 31/12/2025, under penalty of exclusion from the benefits.

#### **Students resident in Italy**

The income and asset requirements are calculated according to the ISEE indicator relative to the benefits for the right to study. Students are required to fill in and sign the DSU relative to income and assets for the year 2023 by 31/12/2025, on the INPS portal or through a CAF.

Failure to sign a DSU by 31/12/2025 shall constitute grounds for exclusion.

DiSCo acquires the ISEE/ISPE values independently by querying the INPS database. Therefore, the application form does not request any of the relevant data, nor is it necessary to submit the documentation on the ISEE calculation.

In the event of multiple DSUs, DiSCo will solely acquire the last chronologically valid one, which must be of the university type, under penalty of exclusion.

## SPECIAL CASES

- **Students with political refugee status:**

Non-EU students with recognised refugee status must submit the DSU by 31/12/2025.

- **Students without the requirements envisaged for independent students resident in Italy whose families live abroad:**

These students must integrate the ISEE indicator, in addition to the ISEEUP indicator, at an affiliated CAF by 31/12/2025, under penalty of exclusion from the benefit.

- **Students without the requirements envisaged for independent students resident in Italy whose families live in Italy:**

For this category of students, the ISEE integration must be carried out by including in the ISEE declaration the references of the DSU of the family of origin with regard to income and assets for the year 2023.

This integration must be present in the INPS database by 31/12/2025 and can be made on the INPS portal or through a CAF.

### Students who are not residents in Italy

The economic situation of international students (with families not residing in Italy), and of Italian students residing abroad is defined through the Equalised Indicator of the Equivalent Economic Situation abroad (also known as ISEEUP).

To participate in this call for applications, the ISEEUP must be filed by 31/12/2025 at one of DiSCo-approved CAFs, with a list of affiliated CAFs found at [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it) upon simultaneous presentation of the relevant income documentation .

Students who have not signed an ISEEUP at an affiliated CAF by 31/12/2025 are excluded from all benefits. For the purposes of this call for applications, no other documentation produced at a later time will be accepted, even if in original copy.

Declarations in lieu, self-certifications, affidavits, or any other kind of sworn statements cannot be accepted.

2. Students from non-EU countries must upload their valid residence permit to the “My Profile” section by 31/10/2025. International non-EU students who do not yet have a residence permit or who are awaiting renewal of an expired permit must initially upload a copy of their passport onto the “My Profile” section by 31/10/2025. These students must upload a copy of their valid resident permit by 31/07/2026. Should the residence permit be issued after the deadline of 31/07/2026, it may be uploaded by 15/01/2027, under penalty of exclusion from the benefit.
3. 3.be enrolled by 31/12/2025 for the 2025/2026 academic year at a public or private University or Academy of art, music and dance (AFAM), legally recognised, active and with registered office in the Lazio Region, excluding online universities, and which issues legally valid academic qualifications, or be among those students identified as graduating students as specified in the definitions.

## ART. 5 Required documentation

The grant application consists of the information requested and entered into the reserved area of the Lazio DiSCo site. The information provided by the applicant in the system will result in a grant application whose reliability is certified by the student recognition and accreditation systems. The system requires the applicant to enter information on the credits acquired based on the table pursuant to Article 11 of the Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2025/2026, for statistical purposes only.

Granting of the benefit is subject to the submission of a specific application in accordance with the procedure and timetable indicated in Article 6 below, to which suitable documentation relating to the grant must be attached in a single PDF file (via upload).

In particular, the applicant must submit:

1. Copy of the receipt of registration of the rental agreement registered no later than 31/10/2025, in the applicant's name, issued by the Italian Tax Authority, any extension registered with the Italian Tax Authority and any takeover registered with the Italian Tax Authority, pursuant to Law 431/1998 "Regulation of leases and the release of properties used for residential purposes" and subsequent amendments and additions.

The registration receipt must indicate the municipality in which the rented property is located or, alternatively, the cadastral code of the municipality itself and the amount referring to the months included in the contract registration.

In the event of more than 4 tenants, a copy of the private agreement/contract must be attached.

For contracts expiring on or before 31/01/2026, registrations of new contracts and/or related extensions must be entered in the reserved area using the "Enter modifications/additions to application data" function by 12:00 noon on 31/01/2026, in accordance with the procedures described in Art. 6 below - PHASE TWO, with no other method of transmission of such documentation being accepted.

For contracts expiring after the end of the second phase (31/01/2026), receipts for registration of the extension or of a new contract with the Italian Tax Authority will be accepted until 31/07/2026 (end of receipt uploading) only and exclusively via ticket in the "Housing grants" category. Any new contracts, even if signed following termination, must still guarantee continuity over time. Any early termination of the contract must be registered with the Italian Tax Authority and submitted via ticket in the "Housing grants" section.

In order to be considered acceptable and eligible for reimbursement, the contract must, by the end of the second phase (31/01/2026)

1.1. have a duration of at least 6 months; in the case of a takeover, the start date of the contract is understood to be the date of the takeover itself. For graduating students only, the time necessary to obtain their degree;

1.2. refer, under penalty of exclusion from the grant, to accommodation located in the municipality or province corresponding to the main location of the course, according to the following classification:

- Rome and province
- Frosinone and province
- Latina and province
- Rieti and province
- Viterbo and province

Note that the monthly reimbursement of € 350.00 is granted solely and exclusively for contracts entered into in the municipality of Rome.

1.3. be registered to the applicant or, if referring to a contract in the name of others, supplemented with a takeover agreement, duly registered with the Italian Tax Authority.


2. Documentation relating to ISEE/ISEEUP must be signed by 31/12/2025 in accordance with the procedures set out in Article 4, point 1;
3. Students from non-EU countries must submit documentation relating to their residence permit or passport, as provided for in above Article 4, point 2.

## **ART. 6**

### **Procedures and methods for the compilation and submission of applications**

#### **PHASE ONE - REGISTRATION AND ONLINE SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION**

The application may be submitted from 12:00 pm on 15/09/2025 to 12:00 pm on 31/10/2025. Applications for this call must be submitted exclusively by completing the online form available in the student's reserved area on the DiSCo website, in accordance with the following procedures:

- A. Students residing in Italy must access the system via SPID or electronic identity card (CIE). Minors residing in Italy may only access the system via CIE.
- B. International students who are not resident in Italy and who only have a document issued by foreign authorities (passport) shall access the reserved area via the DiSCo credentials already in their possession. Students accessing the area for the first time obtain their credentials by registering and, in this case, are required to undergo visual identification at one of the affiliated CAFs  when completing the ISEEUP form. Visual identification is not required if the student has a DiSCo PIN issued in previous years following signing of the appropriate release form. International students who only have a passport can submit their application using the PIN issued by the system and visible in the reserved area.

Students who wish to apply for the benefit pursuant to this notice are required to complete all sections of the form, attaching the required documents as defined in the notice and declaring the truthfulness of the data entered, in accordance with Presidential Decree 445 of 2000, with particular reference to Articles 46 and 47.

Foreign citizens not resident in Italy may not use the self-certification option.

In order to participate in this call for applications, the application must be submitted using the "submit application" function no later than 12:00 noon on 31/10/2025.

For Italian students from countries belonging to the European Union or outside the EU, it is mandatory to attach all documentation in digital format to the application, as required in Article 5;

Students from non-EU countries must also upload their valid residence permit to the "My Profile" section by 31/10/2025.

International non-EU students who do not yet have a residence permit or who are awaiting renewal of an expired permit must initially upload a copy of their passport onto the “My Profile” section by 31/10/2025. These students must upload a copy of their valid resident permit by 31/07/2026. Should the residence permit be issued after the deadline of 31/07/2026, it may be uploaded by 15/01/2027, under penalty of exclusion from the benefit.

Through the “submit application” function, the system automatically acquires the application and issues the relevant identification number, which each student must keep for any disputes or communications with DiSCo.

In the event of errors/omissions in the application, students can make changes using the “unlock-enter modifications/additions” function by 12:00 noon on 31/10/2025.

Activating the “unlock-enter modifications/additions” function cancels the application even if no changes have been made. Therefore, regardless of whether changes have been made, students must resubmit their application and related attachments by the deadline of 31/10/2025 at 12:00 noon, under penalty of exclusion from the benefit.

Students who by 12:00 noon on 31/10/2025 have not completed all sections of the application form and attached the required documentation, and/or have not submitted it in accordance with the above procedure, will be declared ineligible and will not be admitted to the second phase.

## **PUBLICATION OF PROVISIONAL RANKINGS**

By 15/01/2026, DiSCo will publish the provisional rankings, thereby informing students of the temporary status acquired and highlighting any inconsistencies in each student’s reserved area.

Students may be declared:

### **Eligible**

The eligible status assigned in the provisional rankings does not entitle the student to the housing grant. The student’s status remains subject to checks and verifications to be carried out at a later date with the institutions concerned and the competent authorities, the findings of which may determine a subsequent change in the outcome.

Students deemed eligible must verify the presence of any inconsistencies in their reserved area of the laziodisco.it site and proceed with any necessary corrections/additions by 31/01/2026 at 12:00 noon, through the “unlock-enter modifications/additions” function indicated above.

### **Excluded**

Students who are “excluded” in the provisional rankings will be given an indication of the reasons for exclusion and may not access the second phase.

## **PHASE TWO - AMENDMENTS, CORRECTIONS, ADDITIONS**

Only students who successfully complete phase one are admitted to the second phase.

From 12:00 pm of 16/01/2026 to 12:00 pm of 31/01/2026, students may access the application form to make any necessary amendments, additions or corrections to the information declared in phase one, through the function "Enter modifications/additions to application data".

The second phase is a generalised phase for remedying deficiencies.

Activating the "Enter modifications/additions" and "Unlock" functions cancels the application even if no changes have been made.

Therefore, after activating the above functions, regardless of whether changes have been made, students must resubmit their application and related attachments by the deadline of 12:00 pm on 31/01/2026. Applications submitted by 12:00 pm of 31/10/2025 remain valid for those students who have not activated the "Unlock" or "Enter modifications/additions" functions during the second phase.

## **PHASE THREE - PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS**

DiSCo will publish the results of the competition by 20/03/2026, notifying the interested parties of the position acquired.

Students are placed in the ranking based on the data declared when completing the application form, subject to subsequent verification.

The results will be published in the Reserved Area.

This communication is valid for all legal purposes; therefore, all communication requirements relating to the competition results are considered to have been fulfilled.

Based on the information provided by the student, verification of the requirements set out in the call for applications and their position in the ranking, students may be classified as:

- Eligible;
- Inadmissible;
- Excluded.

Subsequently, the ranking of successful students will be published, funded until depletion of the available resources, which amount to € 5,000,000.00.

### **Rank advancements**

Following publication of the results, any additional funds allocated will be assigned to eligible students, using the same criteria referred to in the previous article and up to the amount of the available resources. Notification of the change in status from eligible to beneficiary will be provided in the reserved area of each student concerned and is considered as valid notification for all legal purposes.

## **ART. 7**

### **Reasons for exclusion**

The following are excluded from the benefit

1. students who do not submit the application in accordance with the methods and deadlines envisaged by this call and who have not submitted their application online, logging onto the site [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it) and filling out the form in their reserved area;
2. students who, having unblocked the online application during the first phase, do not send/submit the application and the relevant attachments again by 31/10/2025 at 12:00 pm and/or according to the methods indicated in Art. 6;
3. students who, having been admitted to the second phase, and having unblocked the application already sent, and/or having made modifications/corrections, do not resubmit the application and the relevant attachments by 31/01/2026 at 12:00 pm;
4. students residing in Italy or Italian students residing abroad who do not access their reserved area through SPID or CIE by 31/10/2025 at 12:00 pm;
5. students residing abroad who do not submit the ISEEUP at an affiliated CAF by 31/12/2025;
6. students who do not sign the DSU for benefits for the right to study;
7. students who do not complete the financial documentation (ISEE/ISEEUP) as envisaged by Art. 4;
8. students who, in the event of inconsistencies, do not settle their administrative position by the mandatory deadline of 31/01/2026 at 12:00 pm;
9. students who do not meet the requirements envisaged by Art. 2 of the call for applications;
10. students who find themselves in a situation that excludes entitlement to the benefits, in accordance with this call for applications and the relevant regulations;
11. students who have been assigned accommodation in the final ranking of the "Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2025/2026";
12. students who, not being beneficiaries of accommodation in the DiSCo residences in the ranking of the Call for Applications for the Right to Study 2025/2026, did not vacate the accommodation they had been occupying in one of the DiSCo residences by 31/07/2025;
13. students who occupied accommodation in the university residences of DiSCo for at least one day subsequent to 31/07/2025;
14. students with a university ISEE or ISEEUP indicator of over € 30,000.00;
15. students who have not enrolled for the 2025/2026 academic year by 31/12/2025 at a public or private University or Academy of art, music and dance (AFAM), legally recognised, active and with registered office in the Lazio Region, and which issues legally valid academic qualifications as envisaged by this call. This obligation does not apply for those students defined pursuant to this call for applications as graduating students;
16. students who do not attach all the required documentation as established in Art. 5 above and in accordance with the procedures and deadlines specified in Art. 6;
17. non-EU students who do not attach a copy of their passport and/or residence permit pursuant to Art. 4;
18. students who, in the case of any debt position with respect to DiSCo do not settle their administrative position by the mandatory deadline of 31/12/2025;;

19. students who are beneficiaries of other benefits already provided by other public/private institutions for the same purpose as this call;
20. students who are beneficiaries of a DiSCo scholarship for academic year 2025/2026 as "out-of-town" students;
21. students who, falling under the graduating student category in the ranking of this call, have not graduated by March 2026, or subsequently but with reference to academic year 2024/2025;
22. with the exception of graduating students, those students who have not included during the application phase a rental contract with duration of least 6 months;
23. students who, by the receipt submission deadlines, have not entered or modified their banking details in their reserved area, or have not adjusted any details that prevent payment;
24. students who, not falling under the graduating student category as defined in this call, graduate by March 2026, or at a later date, but still with reference to the 2024/2025 academic year.

## **ART. 8**

### **Selection criteria**

1. DiSCo will draw up a final ranking, which will be funded until resources are depleted, in accordance with the following progressive criteria:
  - 1.1. Graduating students, as identified by the call for applications, who have been awarded accommodation under the Call for Applications for the Right to Study for academic year 2024/2025 and who will use it no later than 31/07/2025, ranked by increasing university ISEE/ISEEUP;
  - 1.2. Students with a rental agreement for properties or facilities located in towns with a population of less than 5,000 inhabitants, ranked by "Out-of-town" (non-local), "Commuter" and "In-town" (local) and, within each of the three categories mentioned above, by increasing university ISEE/ISEEUP;
  - 1.3. Students ranked as "Out-of-town", "Commuter" or "In-town", as defined in the Call for Applications for the "Right to Study 2025/2026" in the section on "Classification of students" and, within each of the three categories mentioned above, according to increasing university ISEE/ISEEUP.
2. Publication of the final ranking list is expected by 20/03/2026 on the institutional website [www.laziodisco.it](http://www.laziodisco.it) and will be carried out using procedures that guarantee the protection of confidentiality with regard to sensitive data, as required by law.
3. Any changes to the ranking position will be posted in the student's reserved area. Any further communications from DiSCo published in each student's reserved area shall be considered as valid notification for all legal purposes. Therefore, students are required to consult their reserved area regularly.
4. In the event of errors, DiSCo may, on the basis of duly justified self-protection, proceed with the readmission/exclusion of students included in the final ranking referred to in this Call for Applications.

## ART. 9

### Payment of the grant

1. Payment is subject to the uploading of receipts and their eligibility, and is made by crediting a bank account held solely or jointly by the student, a prepaid card with an associated IBAN (e.g. Poste Pay Evolution), or an "Ateneo + DiSCo" card, which can be requested from branches of Banca Popolare di Sondrio at no cost to the beneficiary.
2. The IBAN details must be entered, no later than the date of uploading of the receipts, in the appropriate section "My profile" > "Payment methods" of the student's reserved area. If the student has provided/not provided their bank details, tax code or other information that prevents payment of the benefit and has not corrected this information by the deadline for uploading receipts, they will lose their right to the payment provided for in this notice.
3. In paying the grant, only the months actually covered by the rental agreement are taken into consideration, namely October, November and December 2025 and January, February, March, April, May, June and July 2026.
4. The awarded grants shall be paid in two instalments:
  - 4.1. By 29/05/2026 for the months of October, November, December 2025 and January, February and March 2026, provided that the student submits the appropriate documentation, in accordance with the characteristics referred to in point 5 below, into the system by 10/04/2026 at the latest.
  - 4.2. By 30/10/2026 for the months of April, May, June and July 2026 and previous months not yet uploaded, subject to submission into the system of the appropriate documentation in accordance with the characteristics referred to in point 5 below, by 31/07/2026 at the latest.
  - 4.3. After graduation, payments will be made to graduating students upon verification of acquisition of the degree and after submission of the appropriate documentation, in accordance with the characteristics referred to in point 5 below.
5. Payment is subject to the uploading of valid tax receipts relating to the payment of rent, as specified below:
  - **INSTANT WIRE TRANSFER** receipts including;
    - First and last name of the transfer beneficiary (landlord listed on the contract registration receipt);
    - First and last name of the student;
    - Reason for payment, month and year of reference;
    - Rent amount paid, separately from other expenses (condominium fees, bills, etc.);
    - Payment date;
    - TRN or CRO (transaction reference numbers)

Or

  - **TAX RECEIPTS OR PRIVATE AGREEMENTS** including:
    - Invoice issue date;
    - Legible name, last name, tax code and signature of landlord;
    - First and last name of the beneficiary student;
    - Reason for payment, month and year of reference;
    - Rent amount paid, separately from other expenses (condominium fees, bills, etc.);
    - Stamp duty of € 2.00 for each receipt.

The reserved area dedicated to uploading expense receipts will contain to video tutorials, as well as a template that can be used to fill in receipts.

6. Payment of benefits to students from non-EU countries who have attached their passport will only be made after they have submitted a copy of their valid residence permit.  
Those who upload their renewed residence permit by 31/07/2026 will be eligible for payment by 30/10/2026.  
All those who upload their residence permit to "My Profile" after 31/07/2026 and no later than 15/01/2027 (pursuant to Article 6) will be entitled to receive payment by 29/01/2027. Failure to submit the residence permit by 15/01/2027 will result in exclusion from the benefit.

## **ART.10**

### **Communications and clarifications**

1. Students may request information and/or clarification by opening a ticket using the "Open Ticket" link in their reserved area and selecting the category "HOUSING GRANTS".

## **ART. 11**

### **Verification and control**

1. In order to ensure that the "housing grant" is given to students who meet the requirements set out in this Call for Applications, in accordance with EU, national and regional legislation, the recipient of the grant will be subject to verification by DiSCo, the Lazio Region, national and foreign authorities, the European Commission or other external bodies;
2. Students receiving the "housing grant" are required to keep all documentation proving their eligibility for the benefit until the end of the checks and, in any case, for at least 5 years from the date of publication of the final ranking.

## **ART. 12**

### **Revocation of the grant**

1. In the event of irregularities or non-compliance with one or more obligations incumbent upon the recipient of the housing voucher, DiSCo shall revoke the grant and recover any sums already paid;
2. Any declarations must be submitted in accordance with Articles 46 and 47 of the aforementioned Presidential Decree 445/2000. False declarations and/or untruthful documentation will be reported to the judicial authorities for the consequent criminal penalties, in accordance with Articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000.

## **ART. 13**

### **Sole Manager and Data Supervisor**

1. The Sole Manager of the Procedure is Raffaella Lupi;
2. The Data Processor is the General Manager of DiSCo.

## **ART. 14**

### **Publication**

## **ART. 15**

### **Safeguard clause**

Administration reserves the right to modify, supplement or revoke this notice if, at its sole discretion, it deems it necessary to reassess the underlying public interest, without the candidates being entitled to make any claims whatsoever.

## **ART. 16**

### **Appeals**

Students may file an appeal against the final results of the ranking to the Lazio Regional Administrative Court (T.A.R.) in a timely manner and, in any case, within 60 days of publication. They may also file an appeal to the President of the Republic of Italy within the relevant deadlines.
